The Presidents of Churches Together in England, together with Churches Together in Britain and Ireland, are calling the churches to prayer as we approach the date when the United Kingdom is scheduled to leave the European Union. From Wednes-



day 28th March to Sunday 31st March the Presidents urge churches in our nation to find ways to pray, and to enable church buildings to be opened for any in their communities seeking a space for prayer. Churches Together in England supports every opportunity for local churches to pray together and urges Churches Together Groups and other expressions of Christian unity to take hold of this moment to pray together for our nations. This builds on other calls to prayer from member churches over recent

months and reflects the increasing urgency of the moment as Brexit approaches.

CHURCHES TOGETHER IN SOMERSET FORUM AND AGM held on Saturday 23rd February at Bagley Baptist Church, Nr Wedmore brought together Church Leaders, member of Churches/Christians Together Groups and individual members of congregations to share in an interactive 'Spirituality for Life' event. In his own words, **Pope Francis** said his recent pilgrimage to the United Arab Emirates wrote a "new page in the history of the dialogue between Christianity and Islam" and in promoting world peace based on brotherhood. While in Abu-Dhabi, Pope Francis signed a document with the Grand Imam of al-Azhar, the ancient seat of learning in Sunni Islam, condemning religiously motivated violence and other violence, The Associated Press reported. "The document is a vibrant appeal to respond with good to evil, to reinforce interreligious dialogue and to promote mutual respect in order to block the road to those who add fuel to the fire of the clashes between civilizations," said the director of the Holy See Press Office, Alessandro Gisotti, after the signing. "The document is courageous and prophetic because it confronts, and calls by name, the most urgent issues of our day on which those who believe in God are encouraged to question their conscience and to confidently assume their responsibility to give life to a more just and united world."


